Application for Proposing an Individualized Specialization Area

When an Agricultural Ecosystem Sciences (AES) student has educational goals that do not align with one of the current Technical or Applied areas of specialization they may request approval to create an Individualized Specialization Area.

An Individualized specialization area may be created in either the Technical or Applied areas, but not both. The area must must be comprised of at least 9 credit hours. These credit hours can be taken at another university but must be transferred to the University of Kentucky. The student is responsible for having transcripts sent to UK and ensuring they have been received. Courses should be at a 200+ level, keeping in mind that 45 credit hours of 300+ level courses are needed for graduation. Students are only required to have three courses at 3 credit hours each (9 credit hours total), however in some cases to round out the area of specialization some students include four courses equaling 9 (or more) credit hours

This proposal must include:

- 1. A completed individualized specialization area form (this form).
- 2. A copy of the student's Plan of Study which includes the proposed course work.
- 3. A copy of all of the course descriptions (or syllabi) that the student is using for the Individualized specialization area

Deadlines

- ➤ If you intend on graduating in May or August it is **strongly recommended** that this form be submitted by **November 1st** the year before.
- ➤ If you intend on graduating in December it is **strongly recommended** that this form be submitted by **March 1st** of the same year.

This proposal should be submitted **BEFORE** taking the courses for the Individualized Specialization Area as it is not guaranteed that it will be approved. Students who transfer to UK from another institution and wish to use courses from their prior institution to create an area of specialization are encouraged to submit this form as soon as possible after they transfer. Lack of planning and failure to get this individualized specialization request submitted by the recommended dates may result in a delay in your graduation.
